

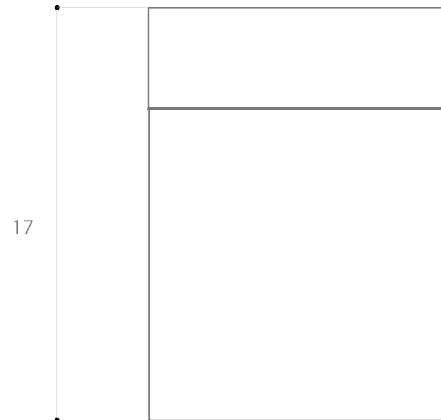
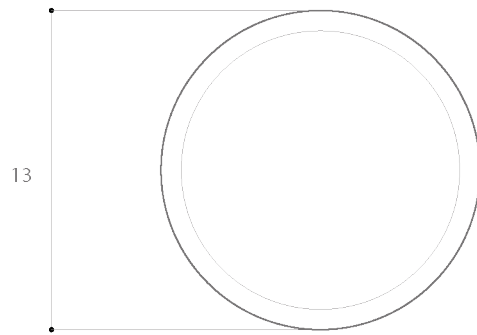

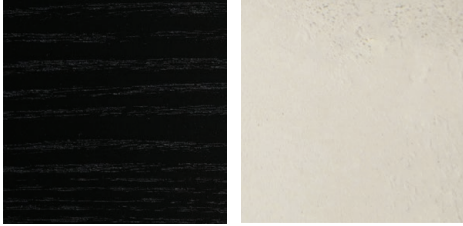

## CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

*Wood*

Carefully clean the surface using a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with clean water to remove any marks. Once cleaned, promptly dry the wood with a soft cloth to avoid streaking or surface damage.

*Reinforced Concrete*

Carefully clean the surface using a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with clean water to remove any marks. Once cleaned, promptly dry the concrete with a soft cloth to avoid streaking or surface damage. In the event of direct contact with water, gently dry the concrete surface immediately to prevent potential staining.
